Planned facilities include:

- Veteran lounge and community space
- Kitchen and gathering areas
- Fitness and training facilities
- Education and employment offices
- Classrooms and training space
- Temporary shelter for homeless veterans
- A small VA clinic

WHO CAN JOIN

CVOA is open to combat veterans who have served in combat zones. Veterans can be affiliate members, but hold no voting rights. Additionally, each post may have honorary members as long as overall memberships are above 75%.



These posts are designed to reconnect veterans, strengthen communities, increase VA care, and provide practical support after military service.
